

Life Jackets

All coxswains and anybody travelling in the launch must wear a life jacket at all times whilst afloat.

Life jackets should be adjusted to give a snug but not tight fit and **must be worn on top of all other clothing**

Cygnets provides four Crewsaver 165N sport life jackets for use by club members (see below). Personal life jackets may be worn but at the users own risk and **buoyancy aids are not acceptable.**



Blue jackets # CYGA1/2/3
are auto-inflating, with a manual toggle.
Never wear in a bow loader
Please use the crotch strap.



Red jacket # CYGM1
is manual-inflation only.
For use in bow loaders
Please use the crotch strap.

Please hang the jackets up to dry after use

Do not leave in the launch or elsewhere in the boat house

Please report damaged, activated or missing Life jackets

Kill Cords

A kill cord must be fixed to the launch driver all times when the engine is running. It's purpose is to cut the engine in the event of the driver (accidentally) leaving the boat.



The wearing of life jackets and correct use of the kill cord are considered vitally important for safety. Contraventions will be taken very seriously at the highest level
